Context clues are hints in the text to help the reader understand the meaning of unfamiliar words. These clues can appear within a sentence, a paragraph, or in other areas of a selection or story.

### **What Is It**

In decoding the meaning of the unfamiliar word, look for the clue in the text to unlock difficulties.

Context clues are the parts of a sentence or paragraph that comes before or after the unfamiliar words that help us understand its meaning.

Two Basic Types of Context Clues:

1. **Context Clues as Synonym** – a synonym or word with the same meaning is used in the sentence.

Example: Lira sat on a bench, she is a **careless** girl as she is **unaware** in sitting on a poured catchup that cause her skirt to stain.

2. **Context Clues as Explanation** – The unfamiliar word is explained within the sentence.

Example: She went home **untidy** with **mud on her feet, stain on her dress and dirt on her hands and face. (Means dirty)**




