READ WORDS WITH AFFIXES

Affixes are a set of letters that are added at the beginning or end of the root word. The new word formed will have a new meaning. There are two kinds of affixes. These are prefixes and suffixes.

Prefixes are placed at the beginning of the root word. Examples of prefixes are *un-*, *mis-*, *re-*, *dis-*, *pre-*, *in-*,

Suffixes are placed at the end of the root word. Suffixes turned the words into nouns, adjectives, verbs, or adverbs. Examples of suffixes are *-ly*, *-ness*, *-ful*, *-ment*, *-less*, *-ism*, *-ous*.

What Is It

Affixes are a set of words added at the beginning or the end of the word. The words inside the box that you read are words with affixes. The words **redo**, **disconnect**, and **unfair** are words with **prefixes**. While the words **hopeful**, **fearless**, **breakable** are words with **suffixes**. Below is the list of some prefixes and suffixes with their meanings.

PREFIX is added at the beginning of the root word.

PREFIX	MEANING	EXAMPLES	MEANING OF THE NEW WORD
un-	Not	unafraid	not afraid
mis-	wrong	mispronounce	pronounced wrongly
dis-	not	dishonest	not honest
re-	again	recount	count again
pre-	before	prepaid	payment before use

SUFFIX is placed at the end of the root word

PREFIX	MEANING	EXAMPLES
-ful	full of	wonderful, beautiful, peaceful
-able	able to be	breakable, movable, approachable
-less	without	careless, helpless, useless
-ous	full of	courageous, furious, continuous
-ent	state of	different, persistent, dependent
