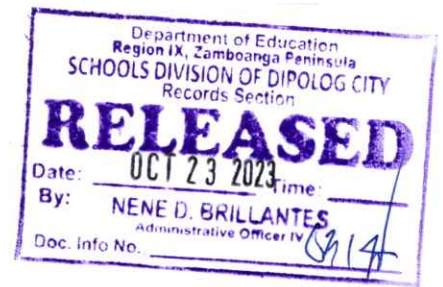

**2023 MAYOR DAREL DEXTER T. UY  
INTER- HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL CUP  
(BOYS - 17 Years old and Under)  
November-December 2023**

**GROUND RULES/GUIDELINES**

1. The tournament is open to public and private secondary schools in Dipolog City.
2. Hosts of the tournament are the City Government of Dipolog and the City Schools Division of Dipolog.
3. A school can field one team only. There is no registration fee.
4. Mode of play is regular or standard basketball (5 x 5). A line-up may be composed of sixteen (16) players <sup>All</sup> but only fourteen (14) <sup>sixteen</sup> players shall be listed in the score sheet and allowed to play in a game.
5. To be eligible to play, the players must meet/comply with the following eligibility requirements:
  - a) They must be officially enrolled in the school they are representing for school year 2023-2024, whether junior or senior high school.
  - b) They must have been born in 2006 or after.
  - c) They must submit the following: 1) Original copy of Birth Certificate; 2) Parent's/Guardian's Consent; and 3) Registration Form with Certification duly signed by the school principal/administrator that they are officially enrolled for school year 2023-2024. and suffer from no disqualification.
6. Photocopies of birth certificates will not be accepted.
7. The Organizing Committee shall prepare the Registration Form and Parent's Guardian's Consent to be accomplished by the school or parent/guardian.
8. A Screening Committee composed of personnel from the LGU Dipolog and City Schools Division of Dipolog will be created. It will examine all the documents submitted by the teams and determine if they are sufficient and the players meet all qualification requirements.
9. For playing uniform, at least upper jersey is required. It must be numbered at the front and back and bear the family name of the player at the back. It must be worn every time a team plays. If a team's uniform is still unfinished, thus, it cannot wear its uniform during a game, it must inform the Tournament Manager and obtain his permission.
10. In addition, a team's uniform must bear the name of the school. It may carry the name of a corporate or individual sponsor but it should not be bigger than the name of the school.
11. The teams may agree on home-and -away games provided that the basketball court and goals of the host school comply with the prescribed standards.
12. Format of the tournament, whether round robin, bracket system or double elimination, will depend on the number of schools participating.
13. A twenty-minute allowance from the last and final call is given to a team before it will be declared in default.
14. In case of double default, the chief referee shall toss a coin to determine which team will advance to the next round. If a team is declared to have forfeited a game being played or already played, no points shall be given to it while the opposing team will receive 20 points.
15. Last day of submission of entries is Nov. 6, 2023. Changes in the line-up may be done on or before Nov. 9, 2023. Thereafter, no changes shall be permitted except for a very strong and valid reason as when a team has to replace a disqualified player.
16. Protests are allowed. For a protest to be valid, it must be made in writing, must clearly state the ground/s of the protest, supported by competent evidence, filed within twenty-four (24) hours from the termination of the game in question, and submitted to the

17. A Jury on Appeals shall be created. It will resolve all protests and questions arising from or out of the tournament. It is composed of Atty. Kevin Limbaga, as Chairman, Atty. Chandler O. Ruiz and Dr. Ronillo Yarag as Members.

19. Prizes are as follows:

Champion	P12,000.00 plus trophy
1 <sup>st</sup> runner-up	P10,000.00 plus trophy
2 <sup>nd</sup> runner-up	P 8,000.00 plus trophy
3 <sup>rd</sup> Runner-up	P 6,000.00 plus trophy
Finals MVP	P 2,000.00 plus trophy

20. Non-winning teams will receive a consolation prize of P5,000.00 or P4,000.00 each depending on number of non-winners.

21. The venue for the elimination games will be the Covered Court of Barangay Sta. Isabel. The Opening Ceremony, semi finals, and finals will be played at the Dipolog Sports Center in Barangay Olingan.

22. The Opening Ceremony will be on Nov. 11, 2023. at 8:00 o'clock in the morning. at the Dipolog Sports Center, Barangay Olingan.. All teams are required to attend in their playing uniforms as the drawing of lots will be done immediately after the Opening Ceremony and some teams may have to play thereafter.

23. While a team must do its best to win, it must do so in the true spirit of sportsmanship and fair play. Thus, whenever an act of violence is committed by a player, coach or other team members, the game officials shall take the necessary action to stop or prevent them.

24. Any team member guilty of flagrant acts of aggression against another player or game official or for any unsportsmanlike behavior or conduct shall be dealt with accordingly, either barred from playing or coaching for the remainder of the game, suspended from playing for a number of games or disqualified from playing for the rest of the tournament.

25. The Organizing Committee shall form a Medical Team composed of personnel from the City Health Office and City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office.

26. In the 2022 Inter-High School Basketball Cup, some schools agreed on the dominant colors of their uniforms, to wit:
