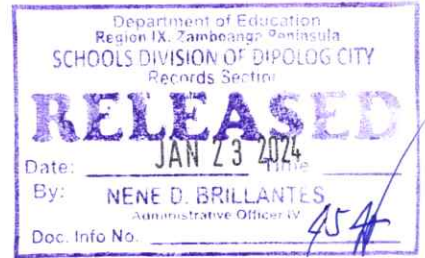

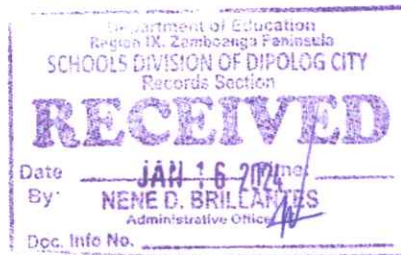

ChildFund Philippines – Zamboanga del Norte Program Area is implementing **Education for Protection and Well-being (EPW)**, which aims to enhance the skills of children (ages 6-12), caregivers, and educators to prevent, mitigate, and respond to violence against children (VAC) by participating in a school-based violence prevention methodology and activities focused on social-emotional learning skills and self-protection.

The EPW model incorporates strategies to effectively reduce multiple forms of violence children experience at school, at home, and in the community. The program has four components, targeting **children, caregivers, teachers**, and the **school/family** work in partnership to build social cohesion, enhance teaching practices, positive parenting, and parental engagement in education, break the continuum of violence, and improve educational outcomes for children.

In this connection, we would like to inform your participants for the final dates and schedule of the **EPW Training of Trainers (TOT) as follows;**

January 28, 2024 – Travel time Zamboanga to Dipolog


February 1, 2024 – Registration and Check in time at the hotel at 2:00pm
