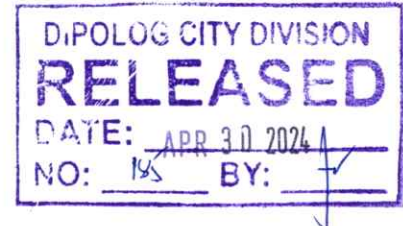

The primary aim of this training is to provide comprehensive professional development assistance to teachers and school leaders, equipping them for the initial implementation phase of the MATATAG curriculum in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4, and 7. This program is specifically tailored to impart participants with the necessary knowledge, skills, and competencies crucial for the effective execution of the curriculum.
3. Participants include all Education Program Supervisors, Public School District Supervisors, School Heads who will serve as Resource Speakers for the 19 sessions, teachers as recipients of this training, and the program management team.
4. Classes affected by this training are encouraged to adopt alternative learning methods, ensuring continued learning in the absence of physically present teachers.
5. All expenses related to supplies and materials for the participants during the training will be covered by continuing appropriations for Human Resource Development for personnel in schools and learning centers, under sub-allotment release order No. RO-9-DIP-24-03-0156, in compliance with standard accounting rules and regulations.
6. Participants are expected to register between 7:00 and 8:00 AM on May 2, 2024 (Thursday) and conclude the training at 3:00 PM on May 6, 2024 (Sunday). As per guidelines outlined in CSC & DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004 titled Non-monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered, participants, will receive Service Credits or Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) for their participation on Saturday and Sunday.
