

A separate advisory will be issued regarding the date for the MOA signing and the disbursement of the grant funds.
- The grant will be awarded to the winning Youth for Environment in Schools Organizations (YES-O) through their respective Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) Presidents. Refer to Enclosure 1 for the complete list of grantees.
- Each awarded YES-O team is responsible for submitting a detailed project implementation report and a financial transparency breakdown, as discussed during the orientation. These reports must be endorsed by the school's YES-O Teacher Adviser and Principal.
