

The Department of Education - Learner Rights and Protection Office (DepEd-LRPO), in collaboration with Starway Foundation Inc. (SFI), has developed the Child Protection Committee (CPC) E-Learning Course to equip CPCs in fulfilling their mandate to safeguard the rights and well-being of all learners and to foster a conducive learning environment in schools.

This e-learning course provides orientation on relevant laws, policies, and DepEd issuances pertaining to learner rights and protection, preventive and protective measures, and familiarizes participants with the duties and responsibilities of the Central Office, Regional Offices, Division Offices, schools, school personnel, learners, and CPCs. It also aims to enhance awareness of handling learner rights and protection cases.

In light of the foregoing, the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) is spearheading the conduct of training sessions on establishing functional Child Protection Committees (CPCs), through the Regional and Division LRP Focal Persons. All Regions listed in Enclosure 1, which are scheduled to conduct these trainings, are required to ensure that their CPC participants enroll in the CPC E-Learning Course prior to attending the training. Further details of the e-learning course, including its objectives and the self-enrollment guide, are provided in Enclosure 2.

Course enrollment details

As a school structure, the Child Protection Committee (CPC) serves a vital role in ensuring that schools continue to be safe spaces for all learners, and thus, it is important to ensure that the CPC is regularly capacitated. The CPC e-learning course is a specialized training program aims to serve as one of the capacity building platforms for CPCs. Elaborated in partnership between the Department of Education – Learners Rights & Protection Office and Stairway Foundation, the CPC e-learning course contains important information for CPCs in order to fulfill their mandates based on the existing policies of the Department of Education. Topics include the following:

1. Introduction to child protection
2. DepEd Policies on Child Protection
3. DepEd Structures and their Child Protection Mandates
4. Preventive and Protective Measures
5. Advocacy and Awareness
6. Elaborating Localized School Child Protection Policies
7. Inspiration from good practices from CPCs

Delivered in a **fully asynchronous and self-paced mode**, the CPC e-learning course utilizes short video lessons, quizzes and tests, links to policies, and other learning tools in order to deliver a meaningful learning experience

The main learning objectives of the course are as follows:

1. To enhance the knowledge and awareness of the particulars of the various child protection concerns that learners might face
2. To build familiarity and awareness on the various DepEd policies and instances related to child protection
3. To clarify the roles and responsibilities of the School Based Child Protection Committee
4. To enhance awareness on how to handle child protection concerns referred to the CPC






