

ANNOUNCING THE DIVISION POOL OF DIGITAL ILLUSTRATORS

1. Republic Act No. 10533, also known as the Implementing Rules of the Basic Education Act of 2013, Rule II, Section 10.3, emphasizes the importance of encouraging the production and development of locally produced teaching and learning materials. The approval process for these materials is delegated to the division education units, ensuring alignment with national policies and standards. The Schools Division Office (SDO), through the Learning Resource Management Section (LRMS) of the Curriculum Implementation Division, is tasked with the responsibility of developing and producing localized learning resources, including **DIGITAL Resources**. This approach aims to cater to the specific educational needs of different schools, promoting a more tailored and effective learning experience for students.
2. To assist the SDO in fulfilling this mandate, the Learning Resource Management Section, has organized various capacity-building trainings and workshops with the following objectives:
 - a. create a pool of Division Digital Illustrators whom schools division office shall involve in the development and production of visual arts; and
 - b. recognize the pool of Digital Illustrators for their outstanding accomplishment as authors/creators of original visual arts in the published learning resources through issuance of Certificate of Recognition.
3. The pool of Division Digital Illustrators provided in the enclosure is composed of select 17 illustrators who developed visual arts of localized Senior High School learning resources in 2023 and have been involved in the visual arts production of various K to 12 learning resources and who also qualified in the drawing exercises conducted during the Division training-workshop for Digital Illustrators held last October 11-12, 2024.

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4. These Division Digital Illustrators shall be tapped in the development and production of visual arts of locally-procured, DepEd-in-house developed, and contextualized learning resources and supplementary materials in various formats.
5. Digital materials, such as laptops and pen tablets, shall be provided to these illustrators using the LR Program Support Funds.
6. However, they should not be pulled out from their teaching-learning activities during school days. In the event that their services are required, they shall attend the orientation to know their deliverables but need not stay the whole duration of the workshop. They shall be allowed to bring home their assigned tasks and submit these on agreed schedule.
