



Dear Ma'am:

Warm greetings from the World Wide Fund for Nature Philippines!

This is in relation with our ongoing engagement with the local government of **Dipolog City under a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed by the City Mayor** for the implementation of our project called **"Cool and Solar Initiative (CSI)"** that started last January 2024.

WWF-Philippines has been working as a national organization of the WWF network since 1997 and leads practical solutions to help the Philippines adapt to climate change, secure food and water sources and switch to clean sources of renewable energy. As the organization continues to spearhead campaigns on climate change adaptation and mitigation while infusing sustainability into the lives and businesses of Filipinos, WWF-Philippines further strengthens our partnership with local government units most especially cities in developing them to be potential leaders towards a climate-resilient and low-carbon future.

With the evident rapid urbanization, cities are considered as the centers of the fastest and largest transformations in population, consumption, resource use, and waste, with city dwellers accounting for over 70% percent of the world's greenhouse gas emissions. On the other hand, cities are also important actors in the transition towards a low-carbon and sustainable future. In particular, to cut greenhouse gas emissions and tackle the climate crisis, we need to rapidly change how we produce and consume energy. Using energy more efficiently and generating energy through renewables (rather than fossil fuels) will play a massive role in reducing global emissions. As the world warms, more energy-intensive cooling services (particularly air conditioners) will be needed, exacerbating the impact on the climate. At the same time, rooftop solar energy can provide much of the world's electricity. The combination of both solutions can ensure we can keep our people cool without contributing to global warming. WWF is working to drive this change through the **'Cool and Solar'** initiative that is active in several countries such as Cambodia, Bhutan, Singapore and Indonesia.

Locally, this 2-year project is being implemented in three Philippine cities namely: *Dipolog City, Ormoc City and San Fernando City (La Union)*. One of its objectives is to mobilize local city stakeholders towards energy conservation and efficient cooling through awareness raising and capacity building. Particularly, it recognizes that the **role of youth and education is critical in shaping the future of cities and communities towards low-carbon future and sustainable development.**
