

BREAK THE PREVALENCE, END THE VIOLENCE SYMPOSIA

1. In celebration of 2024 National Children's Month (NCM), this Division, through the Learner Formation Unit and in collaboration with external partners—ChildFund Japan, MINRICE, and Lihok Bata Development Center (LBDC)—will conduct the **Break the Prevalence, End the Violence Symposia** on **November 15, 2024**.
2. Adopting the 2024 NCM theme, "*Break the Prevalence, End the Violence: Protecting Children, Creating a Safe Philippines*," the symposia will cover essential topics on learner rights and protection, with a special segment on adolescent reproductive health and teenage pregnancy. These symposia aim to enhance students' understanding of these critical areas and equip them with practical skills to safeguard themselves against various risks.
3. Following assessment by the external partners, two high schools have been selected for the symposia: **Pamansalan Eco-Tech High School** and **Cogon National High School**. The administrations of these institutions are advised to review Enclosure 1 for the activity work plan.
4. This memorandum also encourages all other public high schools to conduct half-day symposia on learner rights and protection some time in the remaining days of November, focusing on the following topics:
 - The Child and Youth Welfare Code, emphasizing Article 3: Rights of a Child
 - RA 11930 or the Anti-Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children and Anti-Child Sexual Abuse and Exploitation Materials
 - Bullying Prevention or DO 55, s. 2013





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5. Expenses incurred in the implementation of this activity shall be charged to School Maintenance and Other Operation Expenses (MOOE), PTA-SSLG funds, local funds or other available funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. For clarifications and inquiries regarding this issuance, all concerned parties are directed to coordinate with the SGOD-Learner Rights and Protection Unit.
