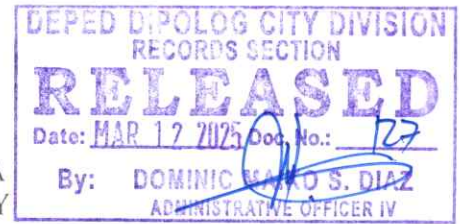

1. In response to the recent project monitoring and evaluation of the Environmental Project Grantees—funded by ChildFund Philippines and coordinated by JRMSU, Dipolog City Eco-Club, and this Division—the Learner Formation Unit, in collaboration with the aforementioned partners, will conduct the **SIDLAK: Wadhwani Ignite Catch-Up Workshop for Pacing Teams on March 16 to 18, 2025**, at **Jose Rizal Memorial State University, Dapitan City**.

2. Three teams participating in the Wadhwani Ignite platform have encountered delays in completing their milestones. To address this and ensure they successfully progress through the 12 chapters while meeting the venture viability requirements, a three-day intensive workshop will be conducted. This in-house mentoring session will provide hands-on guidance, structured learning, and real-time task completion to help the teams catch up efficiently. Participants will also develop improved pitching skills in preparation for milestone submission, fostering increased confidence and readiness for future entrepreneurial activities. Successful teams will have the opportunity to secure funding of PHP 250,000 for project implementation.
