


**REITERATION OF DO 22, S.2024 ON CLASS SUSPENSION AND
STRENGTHENED MONITORING AMID INCREASED HEAT INDEX LEVELS**

- Relative to the Joint Memorandum OM-OSEC-OUOPS-2025-01-01456 or the **REITERATION OF DO 22, S.2024 ON CLASS SUSPENSION AND STRENGTHENED MONITORING AMID INCREASED HEAT INDEX LEVELS**, all Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are mandated to conduct **Heightened Monitoring and Granular Assessment** to include the following:
 - Conduct continuous surveillance of local heat index and environmental conditions;
 - Undertake periodic assessments of school facilities;
 - Implement precautionary strategies;
 - Identify schools that necessitate the deployment of Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM);
 - Ensure compliance with DepEd Order No. 006, s. 2021
- Thus, to facilitate evidence-based decision-making and ensure prompt institutional response, **all School Heads** shall submit **weekly situational reports** through the following:

3. Reports shall be **submitted every Friday by 5:00PM** to ensure timely consolidation and analysis. The following data are required in the report:
- Learning Delivery Adjustments
 - School using SLMs
 - Schools adopting hybrid learning
 - Schools implementing the Dynamic Learning Program (DLP)
 - School Readiness and Safety Measures
 - Schools with proper ventilation (sufficient fans, unrestricted airflow, or air-conditioning)
 - Schools with functional drinking water facilities (e.g. water dispenser, water fountain)
 - Schools that checked electrical wiring
 - Class Schedule Adjustments and Uniform Policies
 - Schools adopting adjusted class scheduling
 - Schools allowing more comfortable alternate uniforms for learners and personnel
 - Health and Safety Monitoring
 - Reported hazards/health-related incidents among learners
 - Reported hazards/ health-related incidents among personnel
