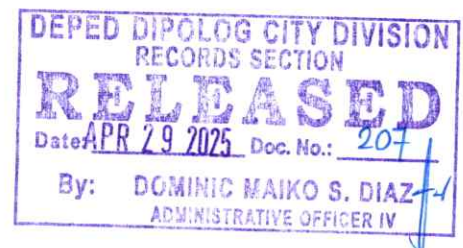

SUBJECT : **2nd REGIONAL SCOUT VENTURE CAMP**

1. With reference to BSP REGIONAL Office Memorandum No. 05, s. 2025 re: **2nd REGIONAL SCOUT VENTURE CAMP** on May 21 – 25, 2025 at Florentino T. Daarol Scouts Camp, Comprá, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte with the theme: *“Future – Proofing Scouting for the Next Century and Beyond”*.
2. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines has been consistent with the Department of Educations’ objective to develop every boy and young man into well-rounded individuals with exemplary character worthy of emulation. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines has been true to the mandate stated in the DepEd Order 76, s. 2012 **GUIDELINES ON REVITALIZING BOY SCOUTING IN SCHOOL NATIONWIDE**”. Scouting with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) is an effective co-curricular program in the leadership and value formation of every child.
3. **AIMS and OBJECTIVES.** Consistent with vision and mission, the 2nd Regional Scout Venture Camp’s purpose is to help young people to develop their full physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual capacities as individuals and as members of the society contributing to the development of a better world through discovery and acting upon their strengths through challenging, adventurous and experiential learning activities in the spirit and ideals of scouting.
4. **QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION**
 - a) **SENIOR SCOUTS.** Scout is expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, physically fit to undergo strenuous activities, and should be:
 - i. Currently registered in the BSP as Senior Scout.
 - ii. Must be 13 years old but not over 19 years old.
 - iii. Holder of at least Explorer Rank
 - iv. Should have a parent’s permit or consent.
 - v. Should be physically fit and healthy as certified by the licensed Physician (with medical certificate)
 - vi. Should have a complete set of camping gears and equipment.
 - b) **ADULT LEADERS.** Should have maturity and clarity of his role, and;
 - i. Must be currently registered in the BSP.
 - ii. Trained as Outfit Advisors and have served as OA or AOA for at least 2 years
 - iii. Must be physically fit and healthy as certified by the licensed Physician (with medical certificate).
 - iv. Must be of good moral character.
 - v. Should have a complete set of camping gears and equipment.
 - c) **Regional Service Team (RST)**
 - i. Must be currently registered in the BSP as Adult Leader aged eighteen (18) to fifty (50) years old.
 - ii. With good moral character and physically fit and healthy as certified by the licensed physician through medical certificate.

- iii. Must be a Woodbadge Holder and has rendered one (1) year scouting service or experience in the council.
- iv. Must be recommended and endorsed by the Institutional Head.

A standard ratio of One (1) Adult Leader for every eight (8) Senior Scouts (1:8) must be observed to exercise effective Outfit leadership management. As the host of this event, ZANDIDAP Council was giving priority to serve as Regional Service Team (RST). Application for the RST should reach the Regional Office on or before May 2, 2025.

5. **REGISTRATION FEE.** A registration fee of **ONE THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (P 1, 000.00)** shall be charged from each participant including the RST to defray expenses for program materials, certificates, individual souvenir items, camp development, meals of the Jamboree Staff and other related administrative costs during the event.

Remittances and deposit of the registration fees shall be done in bulk **ONLY** by the authorized BSP Institutional Coordinator or Outfit Advisors. NO individual deposit shall be allowed to properly account the total registrant. Please see bank details below:

NO ON-SITE registration shall be allowed. Registration Fee is not refundable, but transferable. Deposit slips together with the roster of participants should be email to wmrco@scouts.gov.ph and to the host council at zandidapcouncil@gmail.com. Deadline of registration fee is on 26 April 2025.

6. **EQUIPMENTS AND FOOD PROVISIONS.** Each contingent is required to provide their own camping equipment and gadgets. Other basic requirements and food provisions sufficient for the entire duration of the Venture Camp should also be the responsibility of each contingent. Wet and dry Jamboree markets will be installed within the camp to ensure food supplies at reasonable prices.
7. **TRAVEL ITINERARIES.** Transportation shall be arranged by each Contingent and the travel itineraries shall be submitted to the above – mentioned email addresses for record and reference purposes. Participants are required to be present at the venue at 0800H of May 21, 2025 and will only be cleared to leave the camp after the Grand Closing Ceremony.
8. Teachers participants shall receive Service Credits during Saturdays, Sundays and holidays subject to the provision stipulated under DECS Memorandum No. 143, s. 1997. Likewise, School Heads and non-teaching personnel shall be provided with compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) per CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 02, s. 2004.
