

Enclosure 2: Guidelines, Mechanics and Criteria

TEACHERS GOT TALENT - 2025 NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATION
Performance Contest for DepEd Employees in Dipolog City.
September 5, 2025

Eligibility:

- Open to all: The contest welcomes all DepEd employees, regardless of whether they are teaching or non-teaching staff.
- Any type of act or performance is allowed (e.g., singing, dancing, acting, etc.)

Team Size:

- Each district (North, South, East, and West) can field a team maximum of 10 members in a group.

Diversity:

- Teams can be composed of male, female, or a mix of both or individual, with no restrictions based on sexual orientation.

District Representation:

- Only bona fide employees of the respective district can participate. Bringing in performers from outside the district is strictly prohibited.

Performance Mechanics:

TEACHERS GOT TALENT:

- Each team will present a single, unique TEACHER TALENT performance.

Hand Props Only:

- The use of hand props is permitted, such as gloves, paint, and flags. However, no other props or equipment are allowed.
- Props exceeding 3 feet in height, width, or length (except cloth)
- Use of flammable materials (e.g., fireworks, pyro techniques)

Musical Freedom:

- Teams have the freedom to choose their own music for the performance.

Performance Order:

- A drawing of lots will determine the performance order for all participants on September 5, 2025.

Judging Criteria:

The performance will be judged based on the following criteria, with a total possible score of 100%:

1. Creativity (25%):

This category evaluates the originality, uniqueness, and overall creativity of the TALENT. Judges will consider elements such as transitions, costume design, and the team's mastery of the performance.

2. Talent and Skill (50%):

This category assesses the originality, effortless performance, technical accuracy, consistency and mastery.

3. Stage Performance (25%):

This category refers to the overall impact and presence of the performer while on stage. It includes confidence, charisma, audience engagement, and the ability to command attention throughout the act.

Total: 100% - Judges' decisions are final
