



Your abstract should be written in English and be no more than 500 words. It must be structured to include the following sections:

- Background and objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions
- Maximum of six (6) keywords

Presentation Guidelines

Oral Presentations

- Presenters will have 10–12 minutes for their presentation, followed by 3 minutes for Q&A (this may vary depending on the number of submitted papers for Oral presentation).
- Presenters must be registered and have paid the conference fee on the specified dates indicated: September 15, 2025, First call and October 31, 2025, Second call.

Poster Presentations

- Posters must be printed in portrait orientation on A0 size paper (841 x 1189 millimeters or 33.110 x 46.811 inches).
- The poster should include a header (title, authors, affiliations, and contact details), abstract, introduction, methodology, results and discussion, conclusions, and references/ acknowledgments.
- The poster abstract should be a maximum of 250 words and highlight the study's key findings.
- Number figures and tables sequentially and provide a caption for each (above for tables, below for figures).
- Include legends and other necessary details.
- Cite major references using an appropriate citation style (e.g., APA).
- Acknowledge any funding agencies and partner institutions.
- Presenters must be registered and have paid the conference fee on the specified dates indicated: September 15, 2025, First call and October 31, 2025, Second call.
