ANNOUNCEMENT OF DONATION DRIVE FOR EARTHQUAKE-HIT RESIDENTS OF CEBU PROVINCE

To: All DepEd Dipolog Division Personnel Partners and Stakeholders

In light of the devastating Magnitude 6.9 earthquake that struck Cebu Province on September 30, 2025, at around 9:59 PM, the Schools Division Office of Dipolog City, through the Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), is initiating a Donation Drive for the affected residents, particularly those in Bogo City and neighboring municipalities in northern Cebu.

The earthquake resulted in widespread destruction, leaving 5,013 houses damaged-658 totally destroyed and 4,355 partially damaged-while over 335 public and private infrastructures, including schools, government facilities, churches, markets, and health centers, sustained varying degrees of damage. Several landslides, structural collapses, and fire incidents were also reported, further compounding the suffering of the affected communities. To extend solidarity and assistance to our fellow Filipinos in need, all personnel and stakeholders are encouraged to donate essential relief items listed below:

Preferred Items:

- Hygiene kits (soap, shampoo, toothbrushes, sanitary pads, etc.)
- Ready-to-eat food (canned goods, instant noodles, biscuits, etc.)
- Bottled water
- Medicines (over-the-counter pain relievers, fever reducers, etc.)
- Used but clean clothes (clearly labeled by age and gender)
- Infant needs (diapers, milk formula, baby wipes)

Cut-off for Donations:

October 9, 2025 (Thursday) at 5:00 PM

This will allow sufficient time for repacking before deployment. The collected donations will be delivered by the Division DRRMS Team during their Rapid Damage Analysis and Needs Assessment (RDANA) Mission in Cebu Province on October 13-17, 2025.

Let us once again demonstrate the spirit of Bayanihan and compassion by standing with our brothers and sisters in Cebu during this difficult time.
