

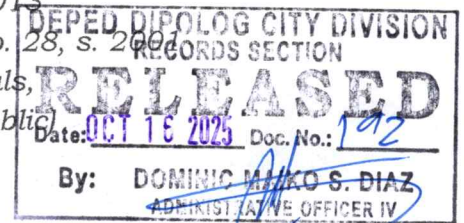

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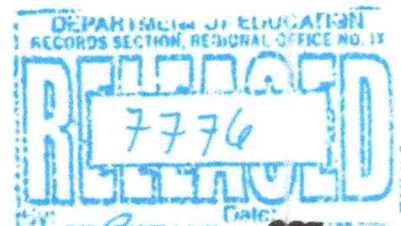
**VENUE FOR THE REGIONAL TRAINING OF ALS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

**REGIONAL MEMORANDUM**

**REGIONAL TRAINING OF ALS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS ON  
THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONTEXTUALIZED MELCS-BASED  
ALS SHS CURRICULUM**

To: The Schools Division Superintendents  
Chiefs, Curriculum and Implementation Division  
Division ALS Focal Persons  
This Region

1. In line with the Department of Education's goal to ensure quality ALS program delivery and the Bureau of Alternative Education's thrust to localize and contextualize instruction, this regional training will serve as a platform for ALS SHS teachers to deepen their understanding of the curriculum framework, internalize the principles of contextualization, and produce practical instructional outputs such as lesson plans, learning materials, and assessment tools.

2. This initiative aligns with the ongoing efforts of DepEd Region IX to standardize the delivery of the ALS SHS curriculum and promote shared practices across Schools Division Offices (SDOs). It also serves to strengthen the preparedness of ALS SHS teachers to facilitate competency-based learning, especially considering diverse learner backgrounds and learning environments.

3. The Department of Education Region IX, Zamboanga Peninsula through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct a Regional Training of ALS Senior High School Teachers on the Implementation of the Contextualized MELCs-Based ALS SHS Curriculum on **October 23-26, 2025 for Batch 1 and October 27-30, 2025 for Batch 2 at Zamboanga del Norte**. The venue will be announced in a subsequent advisory after the BAC procedure.

4. Training Objectives: Participants will be able to:
- Explain the framework, principles, and components of the Contextualized MELCs-Based ALS SHS Curriculum.
  - Unpack the MELCs to guide lesson planning and learning delivery.
  - Design contextualized learning plans and instructional materials appropriate to learners' contexts.



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d. Apply inclusive and differentiated strategies responsive to the learning needs of ALS SHS learners.

e. Utilize appropriate formative and summative assessment tools based on curriculum standards.

5. The participants to this training are ALS SHS teachers actually handling ALS SHS learners, SDO ALS Focal Persons, EPSAs, Facilitators, SDO and RO TWGs. Breakdown of participants per SDO, to wit:

Board and lodging of the identified participants and supplies and materials shall be charged to **2025 Direct Release Funds and Program Support Funds (PSF), OSEC-9-25-100 dated January 27, 2025 and OSEC-9-25-591** for ALS while travelling expenses of the identified participants from SDOs shall be charged to Local Funds/School MOOE Funds/LGU and Other Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Identified participants are requested to present their approved travel authority to the program management team during registration. Participants who have medical maintenance are also reminded to bring their necessary medications. Participants are reminded NOT to bring their children during the training to ensure full engagement in the sessions.

8. In addition, concerned school heads, and teachers are directed to institute measures to ensure that learning activities continue while the identified participants will attend this activity. Teaching and non-teaching personnel attending the training will receive service credits for any days that



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fall on a holiday, Saturday, or Sunday. This is in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.
