Attachment B: Guidelines & Mechanics

I. **GUIDELINES**

- 1. Each team will consist of two bona fide Grade 12 students officially enrolled in the invited senior high schools.
- 2. Each team is to confirm their participation by filling out the Google Form indicated in the letter.
- 3. Participants should uphold the values of sportsmanship, teamwork, and respect for competitors, moderators, and the organizing committee.
- 4. Should there be a replacement, it will be allowed provided the coach informs the organizers at least 15 minutes before the competition begins.

II. **MECHANICS**

- 1. Each team will be given the following materials: ¼ size illustration board, chalk, and eraser. Only the provided materials may be used for answers.
- 2. Each team should provide their own scientific calculator.
- 3. Ouestions will cover general chemistry and basic organic chemistry.
- There shall be 3 rounds for the quiz bowl, Easy, Average, and Difficult.

AVERAGE	10	3	30
DIFFICULT	10	5	60

- 5. The Quiz Master shall read the question twice, and the question shall be flashed on a screen after the first reading. The quizmaster shall say "GO" after the second reading, only then the participants start writing their answers. In case of problemsolving questions, the participants may begin writing their computations during the first reading.
- 6. A buzzer will indicate that the time is up, and participants should raise their boards to show their answers. Failure to do so will signal a warning for the first and second offense, and disqualification for the third.
- 7. Wrong spelling and illegible answers will be considered incorrect. Final answers must be written legibly.
- 8. Any appeal regarding the preceding question will only be entertained before the quizmaster proceeds to the next question.
- 9. The participants are PROHIBITED to use any communication device, especially cellphones, during the competition.

- 10. A short break of 5 minutes shall be given between each round to allow participants to rest and for the organizers to prepare the next set of questions. The Quiz Master will announce the resumption of the competition.
- 11. The total number of points will determine the top 3 winners of the Chem Clash: Inter-School Chemistry Quiz Bowl.
- 12. Coaching from the audience is strictly PROHIBITED.
- 13. In case of a tie, three Clincher questions will be asked, each worth 5 points. If the tie is not broken, Do or Die questions will be asked. The team who gets the correct answer and scores first will be declared as winner of the tie. If both are incorrect, another question will be asked.
- 14. The decision of the judges is final, executory, and not subject to appeal.
