

1. We are pleased to announce the holding of the **2026 COUNCIL YOUTH FORUM** on February 27 – 28 to March 01, 2026 at Florentino T. Daarol Scouts Camp, Compra, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte.
2. **Objectives of the Council Youth Forum aim to:**
  1. Strengthening youth participation in the governance of the Scouting Movement;
  2. Develop leadership, communication, and decision – making skills among Senior Scouts;
  3. Elect the official Council Scout Representative of the Local Council Executive Board and who will represent the ZANDIDAP Council to the Regional Scout Youth Forum.

3. **Qualifications of the Participants:**

Participants must:

- Be a duly registered member of the BSP.
  - Have attained at least Outdoorsman Rank.
  - Be a 13 to 17 years old at the time of the forum.
  - Be endorsed by their respective School Principal or Outfit Advisor and with Parent/Guardian Consent.
  - Be active in Scouting activities, good scholastic record and in mentally & physically fit.
4. Relative thereto, all concerned are advised to send at least two (2) Senior Scouts who are chosen at their respective school to represent in the Council Youth Forum, which preferably 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> Year High School. Participants are required to bring with them tent, sleeping gears, scout uniform, toiletries, and clothes for the duration, etc..
  5. **Registration Fee:** each participant will be charge of **FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 500.00)** to cover for meals & snacks for 3 days, conference materials and others.
